COLLECT

through our Lord Jesus Christ,

in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever. **Amen**

First Reading Genesis 15:1-12, 17-18
God gave reassurances to doubting Abram. Abram could only see what was but God called him to what would be.

Psalm 27

1 The LORD is my light and my salvation—
whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life—
of whom shall I be afraid?
2 **When the wicked advance against me
to devour^[a] me,
it is my enemies and my foes
who will stumble and fall.**
3 Though an army besiege me,
my heart will not fear;
though war break out against me,
even then I will be confident.
4 **One thing I ask from the LORD,
this only do I seek:
that I may dwell in the house of the LORD
all the days of my life,
to gaze on the beauty of the LORD
and to seek him in his temple.**
5 **For in the day of trouble**
he will keep me safe in his dwelling;
he will hide me in the shelter of his sacred tent
and set me high upon a rock.
6 **Then my head will be exalted
above the enemies who surround me;
at his sacred tent I will sacrifice with shouts of joy;
I will sing and make music to the LORD.**
7 Hear my voice when I call, LORD;
be merciful to me and answer me.
8 **My heart says of you, "Seek his face!"
Your face, LORD, I will seek.**
9 Do not hide your face from me,
do not turn your servant away in anger;
you have been my helper.
Do not reject me or forsake me,
God my Saviour.

¹⁰ **Though my father and mother forsake me,
the LORD will receive me.**

¹¹ Teach me your way, LORD;
lead me in a straight path
because of my oppressors.

¹² **Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes,
for false witnesses rise up against me,
spouting malicious accusations.**

¹³ I remain confident of this:
I will see the goodness of the LORD
in the land of the living.

¹⁴ **Wait for the LORD;
be strong and take heart
and wait for the LORD.**

Second Reading Philippians 3:17 – 4:1

Paul encourages the Philippians to be like him, with a vision that is life giving not destroying, transforming not conforming, and that honours rather than shames God.

Gospel Luke 13:31-35

Jesus speaks of the conflict of wills in Jerusalem. He knows that he goes to the holy city, Jerusalem, to be killed, but carries a prophetic longing for the city-dwellers to live within God's loving vision, the purpose for which they were created.
